PARK AREA ACTIVITIES: Several good field and forest trails are available for hiking, mountain biking, cross-country skiing, and horseback riding. These trails, along with a dirt road (Hollow Brook Rd.) provide access through the deep-cut Teetertown Ravine, which traces the path of a natural trout production stream through the park. A 4+ acre Activity Field, adjacent to the group camping area, is ideal for large-scale field sports and skills activities. It is also used for tenting, campfires, and flag ceremonies during camporees. Two ponds are also near the camping area. NJ State Fishing Licenses are required for those 16-yrs. of age & over; a catch & release rule applies for Large-mouth Bass & Sunfish: Rainbow Trout can be kept, per daily State Limits (w/Trout Stamp on NJ License). A pond-side BBQ & picnic area is available on a non-reservable (first come-first served) basis.

WEEKEND CAMPING FACILITIES, RULES, & PARK ACTIVITIES

At the Mountain Farm Section-Teetertown Ravine Nature Preserve, in Lebanon Twp.

GROUP CAMPING FACILITIES –Sites available April 15th – November 15th.

- **North End Field:** (mowed lawn area), has 2 tent sites (A & B), 3 prepared fire rings, 6 picnic tables each; 40/40Max. 80
- **1 Woodland Tent Site:** 3 fire rings, 1 raised BBQ (charcoal) grill, 3 picnic tables; Max. 40
- **1 Woodland Lean-to Site:** 2 fire rings, 1 raised BBQ (charcoal) grill, 3 picnic tables; 4 - 10' x 20' buildings (3 of them with a completely open front, & 1 with a 12' wide x 10' deep open area & an 8' wide x 10' deep bear-resistant enclosed room, with a counter top, Dutch door & sliding rear window); open-spring bunks sleep 42 campers.

PUBLIC CAMP SITES-Sites available April 15th – November 15th.

- **Meadowview:** 1 fire ring, 1 picnic table, 6 people per site.
- **Ridgeline A:** 1 fire ring, 1 picnic table, 6 people per site.
- **Ridgeline B:** 1 fire ring, 1 picnic table, 6 people per site.
- **Hilltop A:** (handicap accessible site, permit parking for 1 vehicle allowed at site) 1 fire ring, 1 picnic table, 6 people per site.
- **Hilltop B:** 1 fire ring, 1 picnic table, 6 people per site.
- **Hilltop C:** 1 fire ring, 1 picnic, 6 people per site.

SERVICES & POLICIES

Chemical toilets (porta-potties) are near each camping area and group camping area. As the water source is ½ to ¾ -mile from campsites, we urge groups to **bring FULL water containers.** You may also fill them at the water spicket adjacent to the Stone House, next to the main parking lot. We urge groups to please **bring tinder & kindling to start camp and cooking fires, to save forest habitat.** Cut firewood is available in all campsites.

CAMPING RULES

- **NOTE:** The Visitor Center is now a private residence. Please do not disturb.
- **Camping groups must check in with an on duty Ranger by calling 908-507-5236. UPON ARRIVAL. Group leaders should tell drivers who will arrive after check-in, or for camper pick-up, to go directly to the group camping parking lot. Overnight vehicles are restricted to approved parking areas. Only County vehicles are permitted in park.**
- **Camping is by reservation (w/receipt of fee), and in designated campsites ONLY.**
- **Report injuries, to Park Ranger (908-507-5236) or Park Employee IMMEDIATELY!**
- **Remove all garbage from campsite to blue park dumpster, located in the Main Parking Lot**
- **or take it with you when you leave.**
- **Alcohol, firearms, fireworks, amplified electronic devices & ATVs are prohibited.**
- **Swimming, boating, skating, & model boating on the park ponds is prohibited.**
- **Group & Public campers are restricted to campsites during quiet time: 10:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M.**
- **Campsite/park furnishings (tables, benches, bunk beds, etc.) may NOT be moved.**
- **Do not mar or deface park buildings/equipment. Nails & hooks may not be driven into buildings or trees.**
- **ALL Hunterdon County Park Regulations will be enforced.**
- **Tent Camping only.**
