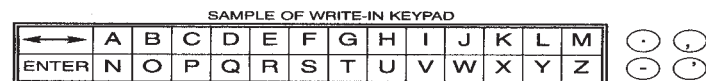
PERSONAL CHOICE (WRITE-IN) INSTRUCTIONS

- 2 A GREEN "←" ARROW WILL BEGIN TO FLASH. (NOTE: THE "←" WILL CONTINUE TO FLASH UNTIL THE WRITE-IN IS COMPLETED).

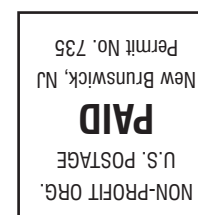
POLLS OPEN BETWEEN 6 A.M. AND 8 P.M.
