

*H*unterdon County is still rich in undeveloped natural, cultural and historic resources. It is one of few areas left in New Jersey where an aggressive preservation program, involving numerous players, can make a substantial difference. Thus, it is uniquely positioned to act now for the benefit not only of residents today but of future generations.

The recommendations contained in this Plan recognize, however, that resources are limited and cannot possibly "preserve it all." Rather, they are intended to provide the Board of Freeholders with guidance on the wise use of limited resources in a way that maximizes opportunities and, in the end, achieves fruitful results.
