



## “Best 4-H Camp Story” Contest



1. Any 4-H member in 3<sup>rd</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> grade (grade is based on grade completed not grade entering) who has attended 4-H camp or wants to attend camp can enter this contest.
2. Participant must be a member in good standing.
3. Story can be written in paragraph, poem, or other creative writing form.
4. Story should be well written using correct grammar, punctuation, vocabulary and spelling.
5. Member must submit two copies of the story. A photocopy of the story can be handed in as long as it is legible, and easy to read.
6. Member should include their name, age, grade, and club name on their story.
7. If the member has gone to camp the story should be an overall summary of his/her time at 4-H camp. It should include what they did, how much fun was had, fondest memory and why he/she want to go back to camp.
8. If the participant has never been to camp the story should include what he/she does in 4-H, their fondest memory, and why he/she would like to attend camp.
9. The story will be judged on the above criteria.
10. There will be one story selected as the “Best 4-H Camp Story.”
11. The “Best 4-H Camp Story” Award will be presented at Achievement Night.
12. The winner of the contest will be contacted in advance so they can be prepared to read their story at Achievement Night.
13. Story due in 4-H office same date/time as record books are due.

**AWARD:** \$100 scholarship towards 4-H camp.
