PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the Township of Readington in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey is authorized to (A) replace the Readington Middle School roof, undertake paving replacement at the Readington Middle School and undertake HVAC improvements at Three Bridges Elementary School, Whitehouse Elementary School and Readington Middle School; and (B) spend and issue bonds in an amount not exceeding \$ 2,364,000 to finance the cost of such projects.

The approved State aid for the projects is in the form of annual State debt service aid, with the amount of such annual State aid to be 40% of the annual principal and interest payable on the bonds.

The Final Eligible Costs of the projects are \$ 2,364,000 (allocated as follows: \$ 1,461,000 to Readington Middle School; \$451,500 to Three Bridges Elementary School and \$451,500 to Whitehouse Elementary School).

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Board of Education is seeking voter approval to:

- replace the roof at Readington Middle School;
- undertake paving replacement at the Middle School; and
- undertake HVAC improvements at Three Bridges Elementary School, Whitehouse Elementary School and Readington Middle School consisting of the replacement of classroom HVAC units

The School District will pay for 60% of the project costs and the State has awarded 40% State aid to the project which will be provided in the form of "State Debt Service Aid". The School District anticipates that its 60% share will be paid with funds on hand in its Capital Reserve Fund.

Pursuant to provisions of the Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act of 1984 (Public Law 98-435), a telecommunication device for the deaf (TDD) is maintained at the Election Division, Department of State, Trenton, New Jersey.

REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

Registration of voters will be conducted at the office of the County Board of Elections, Hunterdon County Library Complex, Building 5A, Route 12, Flemington, or at the office of the Municipal Clerks each weekday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

REGISTRATION BY MAIL

Anyone who wishes to register by mail can do so by requesting mail registration application forms from the County Board of Elections, Hunterdon County Library Complex, Building 5A, Route 12, Flemington at 788-1190.

VOTING REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to vote in Hunterdon County, a person must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of New Jersey and of Hunterdon County for 30 days and shall have attained the age of 18 years by the day of the Special School Election, March 11, 2008.

**NOTICE TO FIRST TIME REGISTRANTS BY MAIL IN
HUNTERDON COUNTY AFTER JANUARY 1, 2003**

If you have not provided proper identification for this election to the Board of Elections you will be required to do so at the polls. If you need assistance in completing this identification, call the Board of Elections at (908) 788-1190.

TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION

A voter who is registered to vote in one district of Hunterdon County and who moves his residence to another part of Hunterdon County must transfer his registration to the new address. This can be accomplished by informing the County Board of Elections in writing. Such notice shall be signed by the voter.

ATTENTION VOTERS WHO HAVE MOVED

If you were a registered voter in a municipality of this county, moved to another municipality of this county but did not submit a change of address to the County Commissioner of Registration, you are entitled to vote in the Special School Election. On Election Day you should go to your new polling place and request a provisional ballot.

If you already completed a voter registration form for your new address, you will receive a sample ballot in the mail. If you do not receive the sample ballot, follow the instructions above, or call the office of your County Commissioner of Registration before Election Day.

Any registered voter who has moved to another county any time prior to 21 days before the election (February 19, 2008) must have completed a new voter registration in order to vote. Your voter registration does not get transferred from County to County.
