ADVISORY COUNCILS: Participating as an advisor on councils providing community input to agencies and service projects. 908-788-1361

BILL PAYER PROGRAM: Help take the s-t-r-e-s-s out of bill paying for seniors with conditions which limit their ability to physically do their own financial paperwork - whether it be check writing, record keeping or budgeting. Training and basic liability insurance provided. Division of Senior Services 908-788-1358

COMPUTER INSTRUCTION: Teaching, Lab Assistance, & Tutors for computer activities for seniors in the state-of-the-art computer lab at the Senior Center. 908-788-1359

FITNESS PROGRAMS: Leading a variety of fitness classes for older persons. Special need for Healthy Bones Class Leaders. Training by Senior Health Services staff. 908-284-6128

GROCERY SHOPPING PROGRAM: Shopping for homebound seniors. Volunteers serve those living in their own areas and shop on their own shopping days. Division of Senior Services. 908-788-1358

HEALTH SCREENINGS: Assist at Senior Screening and Health Awareness Programs sponsored by Senior Health Services of the Hunterdon County Division of Senior Services. 908-782-7224

MR. FIXIT: Performing small home repairs for seniors. All skills and talents welcome. No specific expertise required. 908-788-1358

NORTH HUNTERDON SENIOR CENTER: Located in Bunnvale. Teaching craft classes, presenting programs to seniors. 908-638-6515

SENIOR CENTER: Teaching crafts or other classes, games, presenting programs, serving on committees, facilitating service projects. 908-788-1359

SENIOR SERVICES: Answering telephone on occasion. See also Bill Payer Program, Grocery Shopping Program, S.H.I.P. (State Health Insurance Assistance Program), and V.I.T.A. (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) 908-788-1361

S.H.I.P. (State Health Insurance Assistance Program): Assisting seniors with Medicare and health insurance claims, as well as comparing available Medicare supplement policies, and applying for PAAD (Pharmaceutical Assistance for Aged and Disabled), Senior Gold, Lifeline, and HEAP (Home Energy Assistance Program). On-going training provided by the Hunterdon County Division of Senior Services. 908-788-1361

TRANSPORTATION: Providing transportation otherwise unavailable to seniors primarily for medical appointments and other senior services. Drive an insured county car. 908-788-1368

V.I.T.A. (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance): Assisting seniors with uncomplicated income tax returns on an appointment basis February 1 through April 15. Training provided by the IRS and NJ State Division on Taxation in January of each year. Hunterdon County Division of Senior Services. 908-788-1358
