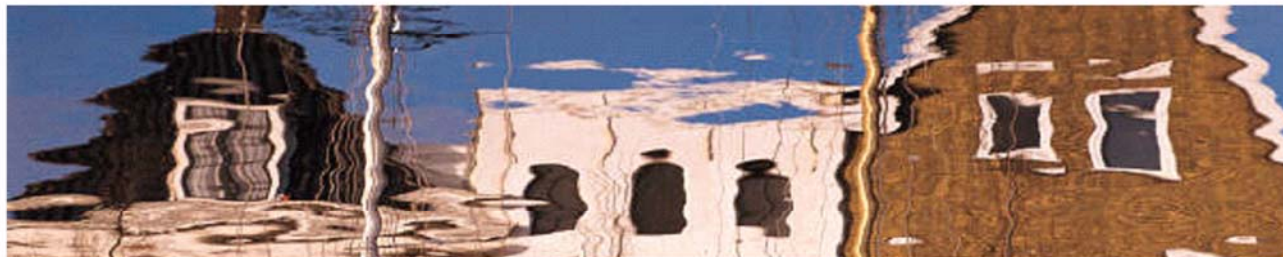

ELIGIBILITY

Artists may submit two paintings or graphics that portray the essence of Hunterdon. Paintings must be framed and ready for hanging with wire and must not exceed 50" in width, including the frame. Fragile, wet or improperly framed or mounted work will not be accepted. Photographs or computer generated or giclee print reproductions are not allowed.

ENTRY FEE: No entry fee; donations accepted. Funding has been made possible in part by the New Jersey State Council on the Arts/ Department of State, a Partner Agency of the National Endowment for the Arts, through funds administered by the Hunterdon County Cultural & Heritage Commission.



SALES

All entered works must be for sale, and, if accepted, remain on display for the duration of the exhibit. Artists will receive 60% of the purchase price for work sold during the exhibition; 40% will support future art-related endeavors of the Hunterdon County Cultural & Heritage Commission.

INSURANCE

Artwork will be handled with the utmost care and professionalism. The Hunterdon County Cultural & Heritage Commission and Prallsville Mill will not be liable for loss or damage and recommend that artists provide their own insurance. Artist will be asked to sign a release on receiving day, and must provide a signed authorization if another individual is to pick up not accepted or unsold artwork.

Each artist entering the exhibition will be invited to attend and to bring guests to the opening reception in the Sawmill Gallery at Prallsville Mills, Thursday, July 15, 6:30 - 9:00 p.m.
