Dear Voter:

On August 10, 2018 Governor Murphy signed into law a bill that mandates that our office send you a Vote by Mail Ballot for the upcoming November 6, 2018 General Election and all future elections due to the fact that you requested and received a Vote by Mail Ballot or voted in person at our office in the 2016 General Election.

Please be advised that the law also required us to provide you with the ability to opt out in writing. A letter was mailed to all affected voters at the beginning of September. If you received a ballot, our office has no record of receiving any correspondence from you. If you do not want to receive a Vote by Mail Ballot for the **all future elections beginning in 2019**, please indicate by **checking the box below in the pre-printed statement, signing this document, and returning this document to our office.**

If your needs change, you may request a Vote by Mail Ballot for a single election or all Future Elections by submitting a new application.

You need to be aware that since a VBM Ballot was issued for the November 2018 General Election, you will not be able to vote on the machine on Election Day at your polling location and you will be provided a provisional ballot.
