Regarding: CAN Message – Flooding Message

Date: June 28, 2006 – 1330 hours

Municipal Coordinators:

Below is the message that was sent via CAN (Community Alert Network) to residents within ½ mile of the river, along the Delaware River.

This is an emergency message from the Hunterdon County Office of Emergency Management dated June 28, 2006.

The Delaware River area has been placed under a Flood Warning by the National Weather Service.

Current river forecasts estimate the river will crest overnight tonight at levels above the April 2005 flood.

Residents are urged to begin preparing for the flood event, including, preparing needed belongings and medications for evacuation if needed.

Residents living near the affected areas should be ready to evacuate immediately upon request of local emergency officials or in the event that their location becomes unsafe.

Residents should continue to Dial 9-1-1 for emergencies only. For non-emergencies residents should contact their Municipal Offices of Emergency Management.
