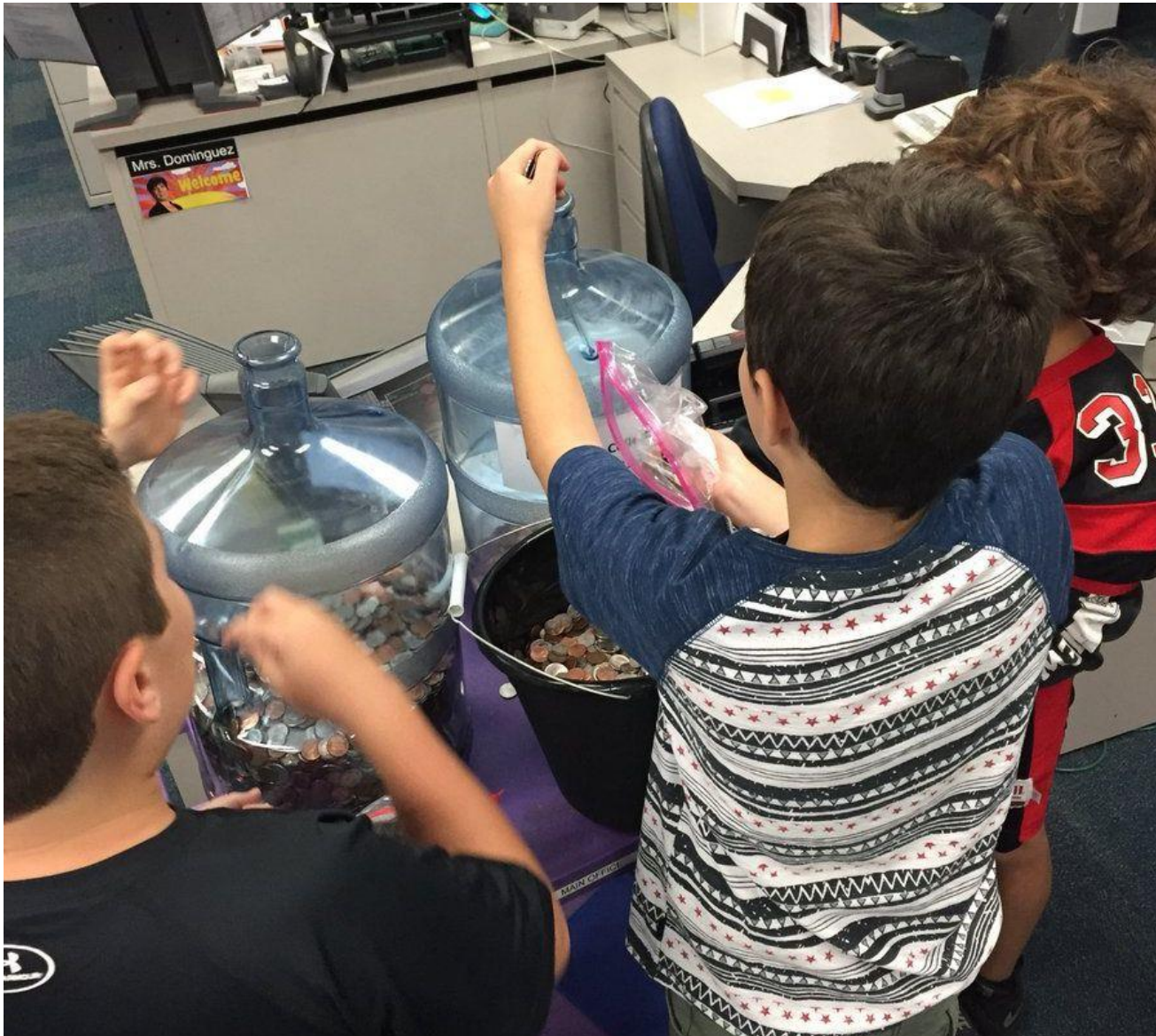


# Flemington-Raritan School District students raise \$5,000 for Hurricane Harvey relief
