

## PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS FOR HUNTERDON COUNTY

In compliance with NJAC 7:30-9.10 notice is hereby given that the Hunterdon County Road Department, Rt. 12 County Complex, bldg. 8, PO Box 2900, Flemington NJ 08822, will be applying Herbicides for the control of Roadside Vegetation on an area-wide basis, as needed, throughout Hunterdon County during the months spanning from Monday May 2, through Monday October 31 2016. Any # route or bridge/culvert within Hunterdon County excluding State of N.J. structures will be maintained within the above dates.

The herbicides to be used in the roadside vegetation program will be contact, post & pre-emergence pesticides applied by low volume truck mount and hand sprayers. We will also be applying growth regulators to turf grasses by this same method. All persons interested in obtaining additional information regarding Hunterdon County Road Department Pesticide activities are requested to contact Daniel T. Upon request the pesticide applicator shall provide a resident with notification at least 12 hours prior to application. Except for quarantine and disease vector control only, when conditions necessitate pesticide sooner than that time.
