In accordance with the provisions of the County Planning Act (NJSA 40:27-4) and of the Open Public Meetings Act, Chapter 231, P.L. 1975, notice is hereby given that the Hunterdon County Planning Board will be hosting a **Public Information Breakfast Talk on New Jersey Right-to-Farm Legislation on Wednesday, November 7, 2018**. The talk is open to the public and will be held in the Assembly Room of Building #1, Route 12 County Complex, Raritan Township from 7:30 to 9 a.m. This talk is informational, and it is not anticipated any public action will be taken.

A presentation will be made by Brian Smith, Esq, Chief of Legal Affairs for the New Jersey State Agriculture Development Committee (SADC) and Alison Reynolds, Esq, Legal Specialist with the SADC. They will be speaking on the NJ Right-to-Farm act, specific to Hunterdon County, followed by a question and answer session open to the public. Topics will include the process involved, protections offered, mediation as an alternative to litigation, guidelines for successful farmland events, and information specifically targeted to elected and municipal officials.
