




COUNT 1 POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED 2ND DEGREE

INTENT TO DISTRIBUTE



Tegethoff, on or about December 14, 2016, in the Township of Clinton, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly or purposely possess a controlled dangerous substance with the intent to distribute, to wit: cocaine, in a quantity of one-half ounce or more, but less than five ounces, including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(2), and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.


COUNT 2 POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED 3RD DEGREE

CURRENCY**

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths present that Michael R. Owens, on or about February 14, 2017, in the Borough of Flemington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did agree with another person or persons, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crime(s) of Possession of Counterfeit Currency, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-32c, that they or one or more of them will engage in conduct which constitutes such crime(s), or an attempt or solicitation to commit such crime(s), specifically by possession eight (8) counterfeit \$100 bills of United States Currency, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:21-32c, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.

**COUNT 2 CONSPIRACY TO USE COUNTERFEIT 4TH DEGREE
CURRENCY**

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths present that Michael R. Owens, on or about February 14, 2017, in the Township of Readington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did agree with another person or persons, with the purpose of promoting or facilitating the commission of the crime(s) of Use of Counterfeit Currency, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-32c, that they or one or more of them will engage in conduct which constitutes such crime(s), or an attempt or solicitation to commit such crime(s), specifically by transporting Iziera D. Johnson to the Walmart located in Readington Township with the purpose to utter forged United States Currency, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:21-32c, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.

COUNT 3 POSSESSION OF COUNTERFEIT CURRENCY 4TH DEGREE

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Iziera D. Johnson, on or about February 14, 2017, in the Borough of Flemington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did with the intent to deceive or defraud some other person, knowingly manufacture, use, display, advertise, distribute, offer for sale, sell, or possess with intent to sell or distribute within, or in conjunction with commercial activities within New Jersey, any item, or services, bearing, or identified by a counterfeit mark, specifically by possessing eight counterfeit \$100.00 bills, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-32c, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.

COUNT 4 USE OF COUNTERFEIT CURRENCY 4TH DEGREE

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Iziera D. Johnson, on or about February 14, 2017, in the Township of Readington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did with the intent to deceive or defraud some other person, knowingly manufacture, use, display, advertise, distribute, offer for sale, sell, or possess with intent to sell or distribute within, or in conjunction with commercial activities within New Jersey, any item, or services, bearing, or identified by a counterfeit mark, specifically by using three (3) counterfeit \$100.00 bills at the Walmart located in Readington Township, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-32c, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.


COUNT 1 POSSESSION OF AN IMITATION 4TH DEGREE

COUNT 2 THEFT 4TH DEGREE


