Patton, between on or about January 1, 2016 and November 1, 2016, in the Township of Union, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did with purpose to defraud or injure the Union Township Parent Teacher Association did make, complete, execute, authenticate, issue or transfer a writing, namely multiple checks drawing on the Unity Bank account of the Union Township Parent Teacher Association, so it purported to be the act of Union Township Parent Teacher Association, who did not authorize that act, or did utter any such writing which she knows to be forged, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-1a(2), and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.

COUNT 2 UTTERING A FORGED DOCUMENT 3RD DEGREE

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Robin L. Patton, between on or about January 1, 2016 and November 1, 2016, in the Township of Union, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with purpose to defraud or injure, did utter to Unity Bank, a writing, that is, multiple checks of the Union Township Parent Teacher Association, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-1a(3), and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.
