
**COUNT 1 OPERATING MOTOR VEHICLE DURING 4<sup>TH</sup> DEGREE


**COUNT 1 ATTEMPT TO DEFRAUD THE ADMINISTRATION OF A DRUG TEST 3<sup>RD</sup> DEGREE**

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths present that Jamie T. Cook, on or about December 8, 2016, in the Borough of Flemington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did attempt to defraud the administration of a drug test that was administered as a condition of monitoring a person on probation, specifically by taking a bottle of urine into the urine sample room in the Hunterdon County Probation Department and attempting to use same to provide a sample of urine, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-1(a)(3) and N.J.S.A. 2C:36-10d, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.

**COUNT 2 POSSESSION OF A DEVICE USED TO DEFRAUD THE ADMINISTRATION OF A DRUG TEST 4<sup>TH</sup> DEGREE**

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Jamie T. Cook, on or about December 8, 2016, in the Borough of Flemington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did knowingly possess any instrument, product, tool, device or substance adapted, designed, or commonly used to defraud the administration of a drug test, specifically by possessing a bottle containing urine in the urine sample room in the Hunterdon County Probation Department, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-10e, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.


