
COUNT 1 POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED 3RD DEGREE

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Johann E. 



COUNT 1 SHOPLIFTING 4TH DEGREE


The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths present that Jessica L. Andrews, on or about April 5, 2017, in the Township of Raritan, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the offense of shoplifting by purposely taking possession of, carrying away, transferring, or causing to be carried away or transferred merchandise, specifically described as cosmetics, razors, hair dye and fruit cups, displayed, held, stored, or offered for sale by Shoprite, with the intent to deprive Shoprite of all or some of the retail value thereof, specifically by placing said items into a used plastic Shoprite bag without paying for them, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-11b(1), and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.


COUNT 2 THEFT 4TH DEGREE

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Jessica L. Andrews, on or about April 5, 2017, in the Township of Raritan, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit theft by unlawfully taking certain moveable property of Shoprite, that is, cosmetics, razors, hair dye and fruit cups, valued in excess of \$200.00 but less than \$500.00, with purpose to deprive Shoprite of said property, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-3a, and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.




