RONALD MCDONALD FOUND

Hunterdon County Prosecutor Anthony P. Kearns, III, and Clinton Township Police Officer in Charge Lt. Doug Higgins announced that the missing Ronald McDonald Statue stolen from the McDonalds in Clinton Township has been recovered.

According to Prosecutor Kearns, "I am pleased to announce that Ronald is safe and on his way back home to Clinton Township. I would like to thank Crimestoppers of Hunterdon for the vital role they played in helping to locate the statue. I would also like to commend the

detectives from the Clinton Township Police Department and the Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office for their dedication and hard work. The investigation into person(s) responsible for the theft is ongoing and we will provide more details at a later date."

The filing of a criminal complaint is merely a step in the criminal justice process. The defendant is presumed innocent until the matter is resolved in a court of law.
