PA MAN ARRESTED FOR INVASION OF PRIVACY AND CYBER HARASSMENT

Hunterdon County Prosecutor Anthony P. Kearns, III, Chief of Detectives John J. Kuczynski and Town of Clinton Police Chief Brett Matheis announced that a joint investigation by the Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit and the Town of Clinton Police Department has led to the arrest of one individual.

On May 11, 2017, Jaimie Baltimore, age 53, of Oberlin, PA, was arrested and charged with one count of 3rd degree Invasion of Privacy, one count of 3rd degree Failure to Register as a Sex Offender, and one count of 4th degree Cyber Harassment.

An investigation by detectives from the Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit and the Town of Clinton Police Department revealed Mr. Baltimore sent a picture of a victim engaged in an act of sexual contact to another party without the consent or knowledge of the victim. During the investigation it was also revealed that Mr. Baltimore was employed full time in the State of New Jersey and failed to register as a sex offender.

The filing of a criminal complaint is merely a step in the criminal justice process. The defendant is presumed innocent until the matter is resolved in a court of law.
