The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Larry U. Herbert, on or about December 31, 2016, in the Township of Delaware, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with purpose to defraud or injure, did utter to J.W., four counterfeit \$100.00 bills for the purchase of a motor vehicle, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-1a(3), and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.




COUNT 1 BURGLARY 3<sup>RD</sup> DEGREE

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Antonio Cruz, on or about February 7, 2017, in the Borough of Flemington, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowing he was not licensed or privileged to do so, did peer into a window or other opening of a dwelling or other structure adapted for overnight accommodation for the purpose of invading the privacy of another person and under circumstances in which a reasonable person in the dwelling or other structure would not expect to be observed, specifically by peering into the window of the residence located at 96 Broad Street, Flemington, New Jersey, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:18-3c and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.
