The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Hunterdon, upon their oaths further present that Todd J. Thomas, on or about October 30, 2016, in the Township of Raritan, in the County of Hunterdon, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did prevent or attempt to prevent Officer Scott Phibbs, a law enforcement officer of the Raritan Township Police Department, from effecting a lawful arrest by using or threatening to use physical force or violence against said law enforcement officer, specifically by kicking at said officer, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C: 29-2a(3)(a), and against the peace of this State, the Government and dignity of the same.


COUNT 1 AGGRAVATED ASSAULT 3RD DEGREE


COUNT 2 POSSESSION OF A WEAPON 3RD DEGREE


COUNT CREDIT CARD THEFT 4TH DEGREE


COUNT 2 THEFT 3RD DEGREE
