Crisis Intervention Unit. The children spent a total of 1,703 bed days in shelter.

The staff and children at the shelter prepared over meals.

While in shelter the children spent hours volunteering. This included helping the .

Upon discharge, 01 children went to detention, 0 went to other programs (such as group homes, diagnostic centers, hospitals), 32 went home, 0 went into foster care, 01 went to live with relatives, and 15 went to residential rehab for alcohol and drugs.

Shelter services include case management, medical appointments including eyeglass and dental care, linkage to community agencies, transportation to court, counseling, and educational/recreational activities.
