History: Having developed from games played in the Roman Empire, **Bocce developed into its present form in Italy** (where it is called bocce, the plural of the Italian word boccia which means 'bowl' in the general sporting sense), it spread around Europe and in regions to which Italians have migrated.

The object of the Bocce Game is to throw your bocce balls closer to the 'Pallino' (jack or smaller ball) than your opponent. The first team to reach 12 points wins the game (must win by 2). A match typically consists of 3 rounds.
