Commissioner Jeff Kuhl, the Board's Human Services liaison, said, "Celebrating the Senior Center and all of the programs available for county residents is important because they allow seniors to remain independent and mobile. Classes for healthy movement, nutrition, technology, and many others, keep the senior community engaged. This valuable resource is often a lifeline for the senior community."

Programs such as the LINK paratransit system, Meals On Wheels, Medicare Information sessions, Art Shows, Italian and guitar lessons, tap classes and Mr. Fix It, are a significant source of support to the Senior Community.

Laine Nauman, Seniors, Disabilities and Veterans' Services Division Head, said, "The Senior Center has been providing programs to assist Seniors, Veterans and underserved individuals in the community for fifty years, something Hunterdon County should be proud of. Often, we are the senior resident's sole connection for activity, information and community resources."
