GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY

Hunterdon County is pleased to produce the 2021 Virtual Hunterdon County Senior Art Show. To be eligible for this exhibition, you must:

- Be a visual artist, professional or non-professional, age 60 or older
- Currently reside in Hunterdon County
- Submit ONE piece of original artwork completed in the last three years
- Submit a piece that has not previously been submitted to a county Senior Citizen Art Show or the New Jersey State Senior Citizens Annual Juried Art Contest & Exhibition

ARTIST CLASSIFICATION

Professional: Person who meets 2 or more of the following criteria:

- Sells or has sold artwork through commercial channels (galleries, online galleries, craft shows, etc.)
- Exhibited in a professional gallery and/or in professional shows for 2+ years*
- Had artwork selected in 2 or more juried art or craft shows*
- Has received 2 or more awards for artwork*
- Holds (or has held) professional membership in art guilds or associations

***Exception:** These criteria do not apply to artists who **only** enter their county show and **never** exhibit artwork in any other show—unless they have won First Place in their category three or more times. In that case, the artist should identify themselves as a Professional.

Non-Professional: Person who does NOT meet the above professional criteria.

CATEGORIES

1. Acrylic

2. Digital/Computer Art: Artwork created using a computer-based program, such as Photoshop or Illustrator; this category does NOT include digital photographs.

3. Drawing: Includes hand-drawn work in graphite, pen, ink, charcoal, colored pencil, crayon, and/or markers.

4. Mixed Media: Artwork that combines two or more media AND where no one medium clearly dominates. This category includes collage and assemblage, but does NOT include watercolor paintings that use graphite/ink drawing.

5. Oil

6. Pastel: Includes chalk and oil pastel.

7. Photography: Includes traditional film-based, digital, and pinhole-based, black & white or color, and digitally manipulated photographs.

8. Print: Original prints only; includes all print forms, such as etching, engraving, linoleum, woodcut, lithograph, monoprint, silkscreen, etc.

9. Sculpture: Artwork designed in 3 dimensions, carved or constructed, in any medium.

10. Watercolor: Includes watercolor, gouache, and tempera.

ARTWORK RULES

- Each artist may only submit one entry.
- Artwork must be the **original creation of the artist**. Photos of the original versions of the artwork must be exhibited; no giclée prints or other reproductions accepted. You MAY submit digital art/photography files.
- **2-D dimensions for hanging artwork, photographs, crafts, etc.—INCLUDING THE FRAME AND MAT—may be no more than 28” and no less than 10” in any dimension.** Although this exhibit may not hang in the County show, it may still hang in the State show, and thus you MUST adhere to these guidelines. Work selected for the state show that does not meet these guidelines WILL be disqualified.
- **3-D dimensions for sculpture—INCLUDING ANY BASE—may not exceed 20” in any dimension and may not weigh more than 40 pounds.** Although this exhibit may not display in-person in the County show, it may still exhibit live at the State show, and thus you MUST adhere to these guidelines. Work selected for the state show that does not meet these guidelines WILL be disqualified.

- All 2-D artwork selected for the State Show must be delivered **READY TO HANG**: matted, framed, and wired (**no saw-tooth hangers**). Paintings may be framed, but it is not necessary; however, paintings must be wired properly. *Use screw eyes for all wiring.*
- Plexiglas is **required** for any 2-D work over 24” in any dimension.
- As this show will not hang, there will be **NO LABELS** this year.
- Any artwork selected for the State show with a dollar value exceeding \$400 must be privately insured by the artist—either through their homeowner’s or rental insurance or through an art rider. *We do not provide insurance.*
- If artwork is incorrectly categorized, it will be moved to the correct category.

WAIVER: For work selected for the State show, Hunterdon County will make every attempt to secure and protect each entry submitted. The sponsoring organizations do not assume responsibility for loss or damage incurred to any artwork. Entry in the show signifies compliance with this waiver. Each artist assumes full responsibility for their own artwork at all times.

JUDGING: Three unaffiliated judges chosen by Hunterdon County may select one professional winner and one non-professional winner in each category, along with a 2nd and 3rd place winner when possible.

First-place winners in Hunterdon County in both professional and non-professional levels across 11 categories automatically advance to the state competition.

APPLICATION PROCESS/DROP-OFF FOR WINNING ARTWORK

Completed online application form must be submitted to Hunterdon County by April 16, 2021 at 4:00pm. No exceptions.

Applications will be completely online. Unfortunately, there is no paper application this year, as artwork will need to be submitted digitally. Hunterdon County is happy to provide phone assistance to individuals experiencing difficulty with the online application. If possible, please take photography without glass for best picture.

APPLICATION ASSISTANCE DROP-IN HOURS: On Friday, April 23 ONLY, individuals who do not have access to a computer may make an appointment to visit the Hunterdon County office **with their artwork** where Senior Art Show Coordinator, Pia Rey-Doklan, will provide assistance with submitting the application. To make an appointment, you must call her at (908) 788-1361. Appointment times are very limited, so please call for availability. Social distancing will be observed and proper sanitizing measures will be taken in between each appointment. If you feel sick on the appointment day, please call and cancel your appointment.
