Hunterdon Senior Center Hosts Grandparent Learning Series

Hunterdon County's Senior Center will be hosting special presentations in October designed to give grandparents and other older adults insights and understanding of difficult issues that are threatening and affecting our young people today, Freeholder Sue Soloway reported, at the September 17th Freeholder meeting.

Soloway, the Board's liaison for the Senior Center, reported, "The County's Grandparent and Older Adult Learning, or GOAL, series provides very topical and needed presentations for seniors regarding issues such as cyberbullying, vaping, and addiction.

As a grandparent, I know that we can often have a positive influence on our grandchildren, but there are social challenges for young people today that are outside our own experiences. The programs sponsored by the Senior Center can help fill in those gaps in understanding."

The presentation schedule is as follows; Addiction on October 4th, Vaping on October 11th and Cyberbullying on October 18th.

All presentations are scheduled for 12:30 –2:00 pm, in the large Auditorium at the Senior Center, 4 Gauntt Place, in Flemington. Please Pre-Register by calling (908) 788-1361.
