### **FLEMINGTON MAN SENTENCED TO THREE YEARS IN PRISON**



Hunterdon County Acting Prosecutor Michael J. Williams, announced that Mohamed Osman, age 45, of Flemington, has been sentenced for 3<sup>rd</sup> Endangering the Welfare of a Child and two counts of 4<sup>th</sup> degree Child Abuse.

According to Acting Prosecutor Williams, “Mr. Osman was arrested and charged on July 24, 2018, after a joint investigation by detectives from the Hunterdon County Prosecutor’s Office’s Special Victims Unit and the Raritan Township Police Department. The crimes occurred in Raritan Township.”

In court, Mr. Osman admitted to physically assaulting a child and to knowingly and purposefully touching the intimate body parts of a child for his own sexual gratification. In addition, Mr. Osman admitted to knowingly and purposefully having a different child touch his intimate body parts for his own sexual gratification.

Acting Prosecutor Williams added, “On May 1, 2019, Mr. Osman was sentenced by the Honorable Kevin M. Shanahan, JSC, to three years in state prison. I would like to commend Raritan Township Police Department Detective Scott Iglay and Hunterdon County Prosecutor’s Office Detective Aaron Lacey for their exemplary work during this investigation. I would also like to thank Assistant Prosecutor Kelly Daniels for her hard work in prosecuting this case and for helping to bring justice to the victims of these heinous acts.”
