PHILLIPSBURG COUPLE SENTENCED ON SEX CHARGES

Hunterdon County Acting Prosecutor Michael J. Williams announced that Phillipsburg residents Kenneth B. Thompson, age 62, and Feleisha Francillon, age 28, have been sentenced on sexual-related offences.

According to Acting Prosecutor Williams, “Mr. Thompson and Ms. Francillon were arrested and charged on April 23, 2018, after an investigation by detectives from the Hunterdon County Prosecutor’s Office’s Special Victims Unit disclosed that they had engaged in sexual relations with a female victim under the age of sixteen. Both were indicted by a Hunterdon County Grand Jury on June 7, 2018. Mr. Thompson pled guilty on February 20, 2019, to third degree aggravated criminal sexual contact and third degree endangering the welfare of a child. Ms. Francillon pled guilty on February 04, 2019, to third degree conspiracy to endanger the welfare of a child.”

Acting Prosecutor Williams added “On May 17, 2019, the Honorable Angela F. Borkowski, J.S.C., sentenced Mr. Thompson to five years in state prison and Ms. Francillon to three years imprisonment. Mr. Thompson was paroled on October 13, 2016, from a life sentence for a prior crime and will face a violation of parole following his Hunterdon County conviction. He will also have to register as a sex offender under Megan’s Law and will be subject to parole supervision for life. I would like to commend the Hunterdon County Prosecutor’s Office’s Special Victims Unit for their exemplary work during this investigation.”
