PEDESTRIAN IN CRITICAL CONDITION FOLLOWING ACCIDENT IN LEBANON TOWNSHIP

Acting Hunterdon County Prosecutor Michael J. Williams, Chief of Detectives Frank R. Crisologo, and Lebanon Township Police Chief Jack Gale announced the investigation of a serious motor vehicle accident involving a 10 year old pedestrian on County Route 513 in Lebanon Township.

According to Acting Prosecutor Williams, “At approximately 7:52 pm on September 18, 2019, members of the Lebanon Township Police Department were dispatched to a motor vehicle accident on County Route 513 in the area of Bunnvale Road involving a passenger vehicle and pedestrian. The initial investigation revealed that the ten year old victim was walking with a friend when the victim darted out into the roadway and was struck by a vehicle traveling south on County Route 513. The victim was flown to Morristown Memorial Hospital and is currently listed in critical condition. Lebanon Township Police responded and were assisted by High Bridge and Tewksbury Police Departments. Lebanon Township Fire and responding EMS members were assisted by the High Bridge Fire Department. The accident is being investigated by Lebanon Township police and the Hunterdon County Prosecutor’s Office’s Forensic Analysis in Collisions Team.”
