



**MEDIA RELEASE - February 11, 2020**

Acting Hunterdon County Prosecutor Michael J. Williams, Acting Chief of Detectives Frank R. Crisologo, and Clinton Township Police Department Officer in Charge Lieutenant Thomas A. DeRosa announced the investigation of a motor vehicle crash involving a pedestrian.

On Friday, February 7, 2020, at approximately 6:07 pm, a Clinton Township patrol responded to a report of a motor vehicle crash involving a pedestrian on Route 22. The pedestrian, later identified as Jack D. Lucas, age 29, with a last known address of Phillipsburg, NJ, was walking east on Route 22. A White Chevy Impala driven by Kathleen Webster of Lebanon, NJ, was also traveling east on Route 22 in the right lane. Mr. Lucas was subsequently struck by the motor vehicle and sustained serious injuries. Mr. Lucas was flown to the Morristown Memorial Hospital for treatment. Ms. Webster did not report any injuries at that time. No charges have been filed at this time. The investigation is ongoing and being conducted by the Clinton Township Police Department and the Hunterdon County Fatal Analysis Collision Team.
