HAMPTON MAN SENTENCED TO COUNTY JAIL

A Hampton Boro man was sentenced to 90 days in county jail and 3 years of probation, Hunterdon County Prosecutor Renée Robeson announced.

Douglas B. Gimson, 32, of Hampton Boro was sentenced by Hunterdon County Superior Judge Angela Borkowski on January 14. He pleaded guilty to three counts of third-degree invasion of privacy on September 17, 2020.

Gimson was also sentenced to 20 days in the Sheriff's Labor Assistance Program (SLAP), forfeiture of his EMT license, and is prohibited from working in the healthcare profession. Gimson will undergo a psychosexual evaluation and is forbidden from contact with the victims.

The charges were a result of a joint investigation conducted by the Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office's Special Victims Unit, Flemington Borough Police Department, and Lambertville City Police Department. Mr. Gimson was charged in both jurisdictions after it was discovered that he observed and secretly recorded multiple individuals while they were in various bathrooms without the victims' knowledge or consent. The charges encompass numerous incidents from November 2016 until May 2017 in Lambertville and from November 2019 until February 2020 in Flemington. Gimson was working as a licensed EMT during these crimes.

Assistant Prosecutor Kelly Daniels represented the state.
